Special Classes offered: Showmanship – Walk only – supported

EWD riders are also eligible for Halter classes and Trail

All Classes are English or Western. Proper attire and equipment are required.

Rules:

- Riders must wear a Helmet
- Riders 8 and older only
- Leads with chains are permitted but discouraged for Showmanship class.
- Handlers and leaders must be at least 18 or older.
- Horse must wear a halter that does not interfere with the reins. Rider must be able to hold the reins.
- A snaffle bit, curb bit or bosal/hackamore may be used, no matter the age of the horse.
- Handler of independent riders must be available with a lead line without a chain at the gate or in center of ring (without obstructing the judges' view) in case of any safety issues. Handlers may snap on to halter in line up or while waiting for rail work to begin.
- Leaders of supported riders must have a loose lead without a chain, attached to halter so as to not interfere with the reins.
- Supported riders may have side-walkers in addition to their Leader, but they may not provide any unauthorized assistance once the class has started without penalties (except in case of emergency).
- EWD riders may ride with 1 or 2 hands and may hold the saddle with either hand without penalty.
- EWD riders are not eligible for any other walk/trot classes at the same show (except halter and trail).
- AQHA EWD patterns will be used
- Classes may be split if warranted/necessary at each show (suggested splits – adult/youth, English/Western)
- Form(s) must be filled out completely prior to entering any class (Special Diagnosis and adaptive equipment/Independent rider). AQHA forms are also accepted.
- Any breed horse is eligible. No membership required.
